The theme set for year 2005 was "Educate and Prepare" in preparation for year 2006 when several of our Republican Legislators will seek re-election. These include Assemblywoman Audra Strickland, Congressman Elton Gallegly and Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger.

After hearing former assemblyman Tony Strickland speak at our Meeting on January 24th it appears that our preparation time will be very short. The assemblyman feels quite confident that our governor will be calling a special election this year to bring some of the important issues directly to the people. The Governor's plans include reforming several of the programs contributing to excessive spending. It is felt that the Democratically controlled state senate and assembly will not cooperate with the Governor to cut spending.
